Dear Parents/Carers,

It was so good to see so many parents at school yesterday for World Book Day, even though I had heard that some of the older children had banned their parents from coming in! It is always great to see so many of you in the school sharing your children's learning.

Unwanted calls — It has been brought to my attention that some parents have received voicemail messages about the conduct of the children either at school or in the wider community. Listening to them, I suspect that they are AI generated and somebody's terrible idea of a joke. Please be assured that if we had any serious concerns about a child we would ensure that we would talk directly to parents. Also, please remember that if you have any concerns or worries, your first port of call is your child's teacher. Mr Harrison, Miss Martyn and I can always be contacted via the school office, if you need to discuss something.

As you know, if your child is ill or will not be at school for any other reason, you should ring us on every day of their absence. The office staff text parents who have not reported their child's absence to say that they are not at school. It is vitally important that all parents respond to these messages. The system is designed to safeguard children. If children are not at school and parents have not told us that they are absent, we do not know that they are safe. Occasionally, when children have arrived late and missed registration, we have sent texts unnecessarily and caused a brief period of worry while somebody has popped to the class from the office to check. We are working hard to ensure that this doesn't happen, but we would always prefer to be over cautious, rather than having a child missing without anyone know where they are.

Acorn and Conker class have been very busy at Forest School. Some children have built dens to protect them from the storms. Others have worked hard to climb the steep slopes, and then slide down them! A group of children have been working on 'maintenance' and have used tools to cut back brambles.

We have also been looking for signs of Spring. We walked around the school and spotted daffodils shooting from the ground and buds on the trees. We've scattered some wildflower seeds and we are waiting patiently for them to grow. This week we made signs to encourage people to walk carefully around our flower bed.
